

Week 2 of World Bowls Championship sees Carla Banks in Scottish Triples while brother Jason plays in the Gents Fours.

Carla joins Stacey McDougall and Caroline Brown in the **Triples** Section 3, and their first tie is against India at 2.30am UK time on Tuesday.

They have the easiest section of four as they meet Papa New Guinea, Norfolk Island, Nieu, Malaysia, Philippines, and finally Singapore. This final fixture takes place on Thursday 7th at 5.45am UK. They should qualify for the quarter finals at least.

Jason Banks joins World Silver medallist trio of Paul Foster, Derek Oliver and Alex Marshall in **Scottish Fours**. Of the 4 Sections this is probably the most difficult as it features both England and Canada. Again only 2 of 8 go to the playdowns.

The fixture list has Malaysia first, followed by Hong Kong China, Thailand, Samoa, England, Canada and finally France. Meantime the Scotland v England match is NOT to be televised at 2.30am on Wednesday 6th UK time. This and the next fixture against Canada could decide the 2 moving to the playdowns.
