

Scotland, with Jason Banks as lead, beat England in World Bowls Championship Fours 14-10, and sit on top of their section by 1 point with the last game to play against France. England are unlikely to get out of this section.

After 5 matches Scotland's Jason Banks, Paul Foster, Derek Oliver and Alex "Tattie" Marshall have played 6, won 5 and drawn 1. Scotland sit on 16 points. They have still to meet France.

Second in the league is Thailand on 15 points (with a strong shots difference, Hong Kong 13 and England 12. Thailand meet England in the last fixture, while Hong Kong are against Canada who have disappointed.

Scotland are strong favourites to go through to the quarter finals.

Carla Banks in Triples are struggling to get into quarter finals as they have played 6 and won 3 with 1 draw. Points are 10.

India have had a perfect record winning all 6 matches and sit on 18 points with 1 match to play. No one can catch them as they have a superb shots difference, Chasing is Malaysia on 13 points and they meet Nieu which should be easy. Scotland meet Singapore and it will be a keen match. Only Malaysia losing and Scotland winning well would get Scotland through.
